



SPECIMEN COLLECTION PROCEDURES

SPECIMEN TYPE

- Aspirate and/or sinus swab submitted in Viral Transport Media (VTM) provided by Precision Health Solutions.
- Specimen should be submitted to the laboratory for testing as soon as possible, but no later than 2 days after collection.

COLLECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. Assemble all required supplies and equipment prior to collecting sample.
- 2. Collect at least 0.5 ml of aspirated material in a sterile or aseptic manner.
- 3. Eject aspirated material into the VTM container.
- 4. Close the lid tightly, leaked specimens will not be processed.
- 5. Immediately label the sample collection container with first name, last name, and date of birth.
 - If this step is missed, your sample may be subject to rejection.
- 6. Place the completed test requisition and any other supporting documentation in the pocket of the specimen bag.
- 7. Contact PHS to schedule courier pick-up.

SPECIMEN COLLECTION PROCEDURES

SPECIMEN TYPE

- Swab of ear and/or ear fluid submitted in Viral Transport Media (VTM) provided by Precision Health Solutions.
- Specimen should be submitted to the laboratory for testing as soon as possible, but no later than 2 days after collection.

COLLECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. Assemble all required supplies and equipment prior to collecting sample.
- 2. Follow specific instructions for type of sample.
 - External infection (Otitis externa or suspected tympanic rupture)
 - Swab the affected area by rotating the swab 7-10 times to ensure adequate collection of cellular material.
 - o Tympanocentesis Fluid
 - Collect fluid per standard protocols into a sterile syringe.
 - Eject aspirated material into VTM container.
- 3. Close the lid tightly, leaked specimens will not be processed.
- 4. Immediately label the sample collection container with first name, last name, and date of birth.
 - If this step is missed, your sample may be subject to rejection.
- 5. Place the completed test requisition and any other supporting documentation in the pocket of the specimen bag.
- 6. Contact PHS to schedule courier pick-up.

SPECIMEN COLLECTION PROCEDURES

SPECIMEN TYPE

- Oropharynx swab submitted in Viral Transport Media (VTM) provided by Precision Health Solutions.
- Specimen should be submitted to the laboratory for testing as soon as possible, but no later than 2 days after collection.

COLLECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. Assemble all required supplies and equipment prior to collecting sample.
- 2. Position head slightly back, depress the tongue while visualizing the oropharynx.
- 3. Using the provided sterile swab, rub the swab up and down the back of the throat to collect cellular material where pathogens are at the highest concentration.
 - If multiple sites are present, collect sites and submit into one container.
 - Avoid touching the tongue and cheeks.
- 4. Place swab into VTM container.
- 5. Break the swab at the breakpoint.
- 6. Close the lid tightly, leaked specimens will not be processed.
- 7. Immediately label the sample collection container with first name, last name, and date of birth.
 - If this step is missed, your sample may be subject to rejection.
- 8. Place the completed test requisition and any other supporting documentation in the pocket of the specimen bag.
- 9. Contact PHS to schedule courier pick-up.
